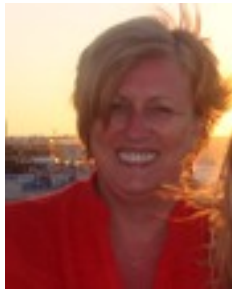


Fiona Magee – profile

One of these contracts was with a government department which introduced her to the PRINCE2® methodology of project management. Always in search of the next challenge, Fiona became a PRINCE2 accredited trainer quickly establishing one of the highest pass rates. During this time she worked with 2 local authorities to implement PRINCE2 into their organisation.

Her reputation in this field led to the offer of helping a multi-national FMCG company to establish their project and programme management processes including an Area PMO for their Africa Middle East Region, based in Dubai.

After 2 years in Dubai Fiona seized on the opportunity to establish the first PRINCE2® Accredited Training Organisation based in the Middle East.
